## **BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) Form**

The use of personal devices such as Laptops, iPods, iPads, mobile phones, tablets and other portable devices are encouraged when used in accordance with the Digital Learning Policy.

Students and parents must complete a new form for each new device a student wishes to use at school. The maintenance and care of any device brought onto the school site remains the sole responsibility of the student and their family. Any damage or loss remains the responsibility of the students, and the school accepts no liability in such cases. Minlaton District School has a right to protect its network and technical resources. Any network user who brings his/her own personal device into the school is required to adhere to and sign a copy of the Minlaton District School BYOD Agreement. From a school perspective, maintaining an accurate record of student devices, including brand and model, ensures that planning infrastructure, accessories and compatible networks for student owned Digital Technologies is always considered.

## **BYO DEVICE USER AGREEMENT**

**Device Type** 

**Device Types:** For the purpose of this agreement, the word "device" means a privately owned wireless and/or portable electronic piece of equipment that includes laptops, netbooks, tablets, iPod Touches, mobile and smart phones. No gaming devices are allowed (to include: Nintendo Switch, PlayStation Portable PSP, etc.)

- 1. The student takes full responsibility for his or her device and keeps it with him or herself at all times. The school is not responsible for the security of the device.
- 2. The student is responsible for the proper care of his or her personal device, including any costs of repair, replacement or any modifications needed to use the device at school.
- 3. The school reserves the right to inspect a student's personal device if there is reason to believe that the student has violated school policies, administrative procedures, school rules or has engaged in other misconduct while using their personal device.
- 4. During school hours the student should only use their device to access classroom related activities.

5. Personal devices shall be charged prior to bringing it to school and shall be capable of running off its own battery while at school.
